

CAMRT FOUNDATION REPORT

Nine applications for Member's Grants and student scholarships were received with a total request amount of \$21,000. A total amount of \$12,700 was granted.

4 applicants for the \$1000 "Leaders of Tomorrow Award" sponsored by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Services (CNSS) were received. The recipient was Corina Geteianc who is enrolled in Radiation Therapy and is currently completing her clinical at the Dr. H. Bliss Murphy Cancer Center.

Fundraising events provincially included a 50/50 draw at the President's Banquet. \$137.50 was donated to the CAMRT Foundation.
