



Professional Practice Report

The Professional Practice Advisory Committee (PPAC) met in May and October 2010 to discuss advanced practice and best practice guidelines (BPG). Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) sites to be used on the CAMRT web site have been reviewed by members and scored for content. The first six best practice guidelines developed by the BPG Development Committee have been circulated for review by the PPAC and will be discussed at the upcoming PPAC meeting in April 2011 along with Advanced Practice.

On the home front proposed continuing medical education requirements for members of the NLAMRT have been discussed and tentative requirements are awaiting approval by the executive and membership. The move for the NLAMRT to become a Regulated College is still a work in progress and much discussion and follow up to achieve this milestone is still ahead. We as an organization will be better positioned if we construct our own application than if the provincial government legislates our organization without our participation so it is in the NLAMRT's members best interests that we develop our own proposal. Several provincial associations have already gone through this process and our organization can benefit from their experience.
